Carriage

Carriage for Forklift - There are 4 sizes of hook type tine carriages rated by the fork carriage hoisting capability. Hook type tine carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades can vary by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
